Utilizing customer premise equipment — the Purple Box — Direct! IP enables secure content distribution between your LAN and the SAVVIS Content Exchange. Direct! IP can be particularly useful in remote geographies or in environments where you already have the required bandwidth.

Ideal for distributing moderately large content volumes, or content that is time sensitive or confidential, Direct! IP provides you and your supply chain partners with a universal platform on which to send, receive and track digital files across our secure, private network.

Direct! IP provides several points of connectivity — the Purple Box, Internet, FTP and others — allowing you to seamlessly connect with all members of your supply chain.

Because Direct! IP delivers content directly to your LAN, you achieve significant workflow efficiencies through the ability to access content at LAN speeds. You eliminate the unproductive waiting game and uncertainty associated with FTP or analog forms of content distribution.

The Purple Box

Installed at the customer premise, the Purple Box combines a CPU to run our file transport software, disk space for dropping off and picking up files, the required network cards for connecting to the customer's LAN, and a secured Internet circuit. Shipped via your standards, it can be installed in a stand-alone enclosure or rack mounted. On-site and remote assistance is provided. In most instances, the Direct! IP service can be installed and operational in as few as 10 days.

The Direct! IP service (including the Purple Box) is offered on a monthly subscription fee basis within the standard service area. Outside this area, purchase of the Purple Box is required.

WAM!NET® Workflow RoutingSM:

Workflow Routing automatically routes packages received on your Purple Box to an FTP server on your local network. This service allows you to extend your workflow to include FTP resources and get your content to its final destination more quickly, without the time-consuming and costly hassles of manual intervention. Administrators can set up multiple routes and define specific criteria for how packages will be routed to each destination. As with all WAM!NET services, tracking within WAM!NET® Info CenterSM, error handling and notification will apply to any outbound packages that are forwarded using Workflow Routing.

WAM!NET® EncryptionSM:

Built upon the OpenPGP standard, we have embedded support for encryption into our WAM!NET® Transmission Director XSM (TDX) transport application. Now you can easily create, distribute and manage PGP keys and protect critical content before it is transmitted over the SAVVIS Content Exchange. Encryption and decryption are handled automatically by TDX so users can continue with their daily activities unhindered by the encryption process, but with the assurance that their files are protected. The encryption process takes place on your equipment and SAVVIS is never in possession of the private key. There is a nominal subscription fee for customers who wish to send files using encryption, however any customer can receive and decrypt encrypted packages at no cost.

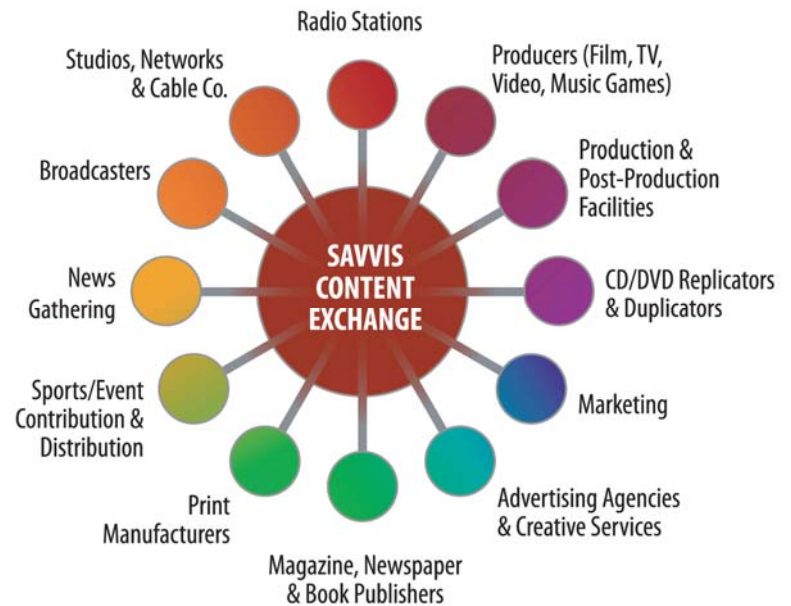
